<u>Equipment:</u>

The cameras, equipment, and computers that we use are to be taken care with EXTREME caution. All of the equipment has been paid for with yearbook funds and are very expensive. Students will check ALL equipment in and out with Mrs. Atterbury before taking it to use. **Equipment damaged or lost while in the student's possession will be the responsibility of the students to pay for/fix/replace.**

Safety:

Students will be leaving school grounds during the school day to sell ads for a few weeks out of the school year during their scheduled yearbook class time. <u>A</u> **separate permission slip is provided and must be signed BEFORE student is allowed to participate**. For their safety, students are expected to continue to follow school rules while off of campus while selling ads.

While at events (sports games, club activities, etc.) students will be expected to follow guidelines of the event. Be sure that you are close enough to take great pictures but not so close that you interfere with the event in any way. If you are asked to step back/away, listen!
