## Superintendent's Summary

The board opened the reorganization meeting and accepted the certified election results with the approval of Aaron Bently, Shauna Young, and Sarah Wies being elected and sworn in as returning board members. Skip Vandelicht and Matt Hudson retained their positions as President and Vice President respectively

Student Representatives to the Board, Allie Spielbauer and Addie Huster reported on the recent activities of the high school. The block the door activities to gather donations for the local food pantry were a success. FFA, Baseball, Track, and Golf were highlighted as well.

Mrs. Huster delivered her report highlighting the data team progress monitoring in math. The first round of data was encouraging as many students scored well on their assessments and she is interested to see how these scores improve and compare in the future.

Mrs. Arnette gave her report and complimented the work of her staff in the area of their DCI work in regards to standards based grading and scoring rubrics. She has seen incredible growth with her staff as a whole and their efforts in collaboration are improving all the time.

Mr. Dobson's high school report also highlighted the block the door activities as well as the upcoming EOC schedules. He also complimented Kay Sullivan and Melissa Innes in their FFA competitions for advancing to district competition.

Mr. Doolin's reported on the vocational completers at MATC in Moberly. He also spoke to the teacher baseline salary grant for next year and the district's participation. He spoke to attending two different sessions at Jefferson City at the capital and the legislation being proposed in regards to property taxes and assessed valuation changes. How the district is going to be affected by those items is unknown as there are several different proposals being discussed at the Capital.

The board took the following actions:

- 6. Tabled the Scope of Work agreement with Veregy
- 7. Approved the usage of a volunteer construction agreement for a football concession stand
- 8. Approved the move to a new conference for athletic and activity participation
- 9. Approved the addition of girls golf

Closed Session Discussion included the acceptance of resignation letters, and the hiring for the following positions: elementary principal, 3 elementary teaching positions, CMS PE/Health teacher, FHS ELA teacher, and FHS head football coach.
